POINTS

Points will be awarded on the basis of 60 points (in each category) for the winner down to 1 for sixtieth place in each event. The winners will be the riders with the highest aggregate total of points from up to four events. If more than one rider achieves the same number of points, then their 5th highest placing will be used to determine the winner. The Veteran categories are open to both Open and Female. Female Veterans will receive an additional 8 years on Target Time. The Veterans competitions will be run over the same distance as the Female's competition. The competition for Paracyclist's is based on a "Factored Time" system.
